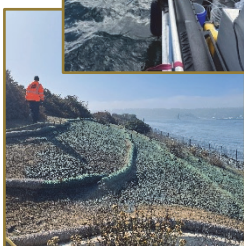
Past Performance

Trevet has provided environmental services to the Navy through Naval Facilities Engineering Systems Command (NAVFAC) Southwest under the CERCLA, RCRA, and petroleum programs for more than 20 years. As the managing joint venture partner for a \$100 million small business A-E IDIQ contract awarded in 2017, **Trevet** supported CERCLA/RCRA environmental studies, investigations, engineering, and munitions response at active and BRAC facilities. Other NAVFAC Southwest contract experience includes blanket purchase agreement emergency response services for spill cleanup under two prior contracts and 35 8(a) federal program direct award contracts. To date, over 280 task orders valued at more than \$160 million have been awarded to **Trevet**.
