Scope of Work

The contract scope consists of planning and investigation activities, including analytical sampling; engineering support and remedial design; and response actions, removal, and operations and maintenance support. Work may be HTRW or MMR support focused. Emerging contaminants such as PFAS may also be the focus or a part of investigations and restoration activities.
